ASSEMBLYWOMAN MICHELLE SCHIMEL BRINGS THE FIGHT FOR MICROSTAMPING TO LONG ISLAND

As a result of the State Senate's failure to pass microstamping legislation (A.6468c/S.6005a), Assemblywoman Michelle Schimel, Senator Eric Schneiderman and members of the law enforcement community have brought the fight to help police solve more gun crimes to Long Island. The Senators, who voted no on microstamping, including all seven of Long Island's GOP Senators, sent a clear message to law enforcement officials and victims of gun violence and their families: **You Don't Matter!**

At a press conference held on Saturday at Nassau University Medical Center, Michelle, New Yorkers Against Gun Violence and local law enforcement officials sent a message of their own to the Senators that opposed the bill: **IT IS TIME TO PUT THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC BEFORE THE INTERESTS OF THE GUN LOBBY!**
